
Le Grill Alpin - Cheval Blanc


Alessandro




Beef Bar Courchevel




Horse-drawn carriage ride

Dogsled ride


Climb aboard a sleigh and let yourself be guided through the forest to reach the pretty Praméruel plateau.

Hot-air balloon flight


At sunrise, climb aboard a hot-air balloon decked out in the colours of Barrière Les Neiges and soar over the peaks of the Alps in complete harmony.


H125 SINGLE ENGINE

Produced by Airbus, this light and versatile helicopter is known for its high altitude performance.




H130 SINGLE ENGINE

The H130 is derived from Airbus' Ecureuil family of light helicopters, which is renowned for its performance, reliability, and safety.




AS355 TWIN ENGINE
